INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSIGNMENT APPLICATION [TM/SM-35a]

NOTES:

- An application for assignment of a registration must be on a form provided by the Illinois Secretary of State. This application must include the goodwill of the business in which the Mark is used, or with the part of the goodwill of the business connected with the use of and symbolized by the Mark.
- A \$5 Recording Fee must accompany the completed application in the form of a check or money order payable to Illinois Secretary of State.
- The assignment form must be typed, laser-printed or legibly printed in black ink.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Accurate information for the current Registrant, i.e., the Assignor, must be given in items 1 through 4.
2. The name of the Mark, the registration number and the original date of registration must appear where indicated in item 5.
3. Items 6 through 10 must exhibit accurate information about the new Owner/Assignee.

Signature and Contact Information: The Assignor or the Attorney-in-Fact for the Assignor must sign the assignment application. The capacity in which the person is signing must be given, i.e., Registrant, Officer, Attorney-in-Fact. Photocopied, stamped or faxed signatures are not accepted.

Duration and Renewal: A certificate indicating the assignment of ownership may be issued for the remainder of the current term of the Mark. An assignment of any registration under this Act shall be void as against any subsequent purchaser for valuable consideration without notice, unless it is recorded with the Secretary of State within three months after the date thereof or prior to such subsequent purchase.
