Vanity/Personalized Plates

- No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after a plate has been ordered or if the request form is incorrectly completed.
- The Secretary of State's office is authorized to recall a plate determined to be obscene or offensive.
- All request forms should indicate whether or not you want the Secretary of State to assign one of your choices with the next available number if your exact request is unavailable.
- If you wish to submit more than three requests, attach additional selections to the request form.
- Numbers are required to precede letters on Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle and Motorcycle plates.

DO NOT

- Intermix letters and numbers
- Use a space between numbers
- Use lowercase letters
- Use characters, symbols, foreign words or symbols of punctuation, such as dashes or periods
- Select obscene or offensive combinations

First-Time Registrations

- Money must accompany request forms on all first-time registrations.
- A leased vehicle is eligible for vanity or personalized plates.

Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle/Motorcycle Plates

- To qualify for Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle/Motorcycle License Plates, motor vehicles and motorcycles must be 25 years old. Firefighting vehicles must be at least 20 years old.
- An antique vehicle may be a “bona fide replica” — an exact copy of the original in design, frame and mechanical operation. “Fascimiles” — close, but not exact, reproductions of the original — do not qualify for Antique plates.
- During the months of January-March and November-December, vehicles displaying Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle plates may only be driven to and returning from an antique show or exhibition, service station or demonstration.
- During the months of April-October, vehicles registered as an Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle may be driven on the highways without being subject to the restrictions of standard Antique Vehicle plates.
- Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle/Motorcycle License Plates have a staggered expiration and must be renewed annually.

To purchase Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle/Motorcycle plates, please submit an Application for Title/Registration, Expanded-Use Antique Verification form and current registration ID card or assigned title, along with the appropriate plates request form and the following applicable fees:

Random-Number Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle Plates

- First-time issuance — \$51 (\$51 Antique Vehicle plate fee)
- Annual renewal — \$51 (\$51 Antique Vehicle plate fee)

Vanity Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle Plates

- First-time issuance — \$145 (\$51 Antique Vehicle plate fee, \$94 vanity fee)
- Annual renewal — \$64 (\$51 Antique Vehicle plate fee, \$13 vanity fee)

Personalized Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle Plates

- First-time issuance — \$98 (\$51 Antique Vehicle plate fee, \$47 personalized fee)
- Annual renewal — \$58 (\$51 Antique Vehicle plate fee, \$7 personalized fee)

Random-Number Expanded-Use Antique Motorcycle Plates

- First-time issuance — \$51 (\$51 Antique Motorcycle plate fee)
- Annual renewal — \$51 (\$51 Antique Motorcycle plate fee)

Vanity Expanded-Use Antique Motorcycle Plates

- First-time issuance — \$101 (\$51 Antique Motorcycle plate fee, \$50 vanity fee)
- Annual renewal — \$64 (\$51 Antique Motorcycle plate fee, \$13 vanity fee)

Personalized Expanded-Use Antique Vehicle Plates

- First-time issuance — \$76 (\$51 Antique Motorcycle plate fee, \$25 personalized fee)
- Annual renewal — \$58 (\$51 Antique Motorcycle plate fee, \$7 personalized fee)
