SCHOOL BUS INSURANCE AFFIRMATION**

I, _____ as the certificate of title holder, or as the individual with signing authority for _____, as stated on a certificate of title, affirm that the following vehicle(s), (VIN #) _____, are designated as a school bus under the Illinois Vehicle Code, Section 1-182 (625 ILCS 5/1-182) and therefore meet the requirements set forth in Section 12-707.01 for the minimum amount of liability insurance required by law to operate a school bus in the State of Illinois.

Please check the appropriate type of liability insurance based on the vehicle's purpose.

_____ I, thereby, affirm that the following vehicle(s) that is/are used for the purpose which requires a school bus driver permit under Section 6-104 of the Illinois Vehicle Code has/have a:

- _____ (1) \$2,000,000 combined single limit primary commercial automobile policy; or
_____ (2) \$1,000,000 million primary commercial automobile policy and a minimum \$5,000,000 excess or umbrella liability policy.

If the vehicle is insured under an intergovernmental cooperative or is self-insured, then the owner must attest that the insurance provided on the vehicle(s) is equivalent or greater than paragraph (1).

_____ ***I, thereby, affirm that the following vehicle(s) have the equivalent or greater liability insurance coverage pursuant to subsection (b) of Section 12-707.01 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.***

I, thereby, affirm that the following vehicle(s) that is/are used for a purpose that requires a school bus driver permit under Section 6-104 of this Code and is used solely in connection with the *operation of private day care facilities, day camps, summer camps, or nursery schools* has/have:

- _____ (1) a minimum liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident.

This affirmation shall be valid for the full two-year registration period; however, if at any time the Secretary of State has reason to believe that the vehicles are uninsured or underinsured the Secretary of State may require a certificate of insurance or its equivalent to ensure the vehicle is compliant with Section 12-707.01 of the Illinois Vehicle Code. If a certificate of insurance or its equivalent is not produced within two-calendar days after the request was made, the Secretary of State may revoke the vehicle's registration until the Secretary of State is assured the vehicle is compliant with the minimum insurance requirements.

Under penalties of perjury, the undersigned states that the above statements are true and correct and will assume all liability and costs for any litigation that may arise from this affirmation.
